

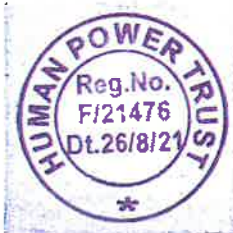

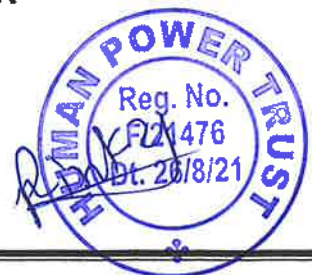

We propose to build a huge Hospital complex, medical college for u post graduate medical studies, multispecialty medical education center, Dental College Nursing.



Ambulance would be equipped with modern clinical care/cardiac resuscitation facility and managed by specialist staff from the MSHRC who will be capable of performing emergency investigations and surgical interventions. Mobile dispensaries for interior/ distant areas for establishment of excellent primary healthcare services. Network of centers for trauma care and emergency services with conveyance facilities on national and the state highways and also being planned.

4. Intensive Care unit equipped with the latest modular invasive monitoring system (HP) and advanced life support equipment capable of managing complicated neurosurgical and neurological patients effectively. The nursing ratio is one to one. All associated specialists like respiratory physicians, nephrologists and endocrinologists like respiratory physicians, nephrologists and endocrinologists should be available round the clock.



fractionated treatment (stereo tactic Radiotherapy —SRT) for benign and malignant tumors not suitable for SRS.

Computer Assisted Neurosurgery, operating computer with an accuracy of 1 mm in which images of the patient's brain can be directly transferred from the MRI or CT Scan to the Operating Table. The surgeon can join the probe to different parts of the brain and retrieve the images previously taken. This is of great help not only in locating difficult tumors, but also in avoiding critical structures and ensuring completeness of excision. Surgery for abnormal movements, epilepsy and small deep malformation can be done.

Image guided Frame less stereot allows surgery in eloquent areas.

A machine with biplane rotational angio facilities is utilized embolization of arteriovenous malformations, treatment of g....aneurysms by proximal occlusion and endovascular packing used GDC system, Thrombolysis by injection of Urokinase directly thrombus in the specific artery in the treatment of brain attack Angioplasty and stenting to prevent stroke, treatment for Vasculesions such dural AV malformations carotid-cavernous fis...hemangiomas of the head nad nect, vascular tumors.

Microsurgical Instruments :

Neuroendoscopy equipment for minimally invasive endoscopy removal of certain tumors (e.g. intraventricular and pituitary tumor third ventriculostomy in the treatment of hydrocephalus, drainage brain abscesses angicysts.

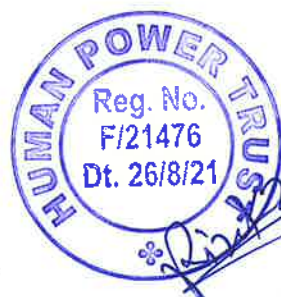

Characteristics of Market

India's healthcare industry is worth Rs. 93,000 crore today roughly 4% of the country's gross domestic product. Knock off the entire Pharmaceuticals business from that many regarded drugs as separate industry to focus purely its on things like hospitals, health insurance, managed care, still this is a Rs.81,000 crore industry. That's equal to the turnover of the country's 12 largest private sector companies including Reliance industries, Hindustan Lever ltd.(HLL) and ITC: But that's just the tease. The real stuff, a heartbeat away, is what Asian Health's Bagaria has to say, and based on studies done by the Firm. India's healthcare industry is expected to grow by around 13% a year for the next six years. In other words, in between now and 2018, it can keep adding the turnover of the Rs.10000/- Crore HLL, each year. Throw Pharmaceuticals back to the pile and it could be adding the Reliance every year.

In fact, a few factors are expected to power India's massive healthcare engine. Since healthcare is dependent on the people served, India's huge population comes in handy. To grow the business by the estimated Rs.8000/- crore every year, per capital expenditure needs to rise by only Rs.80 a year from the current level of Rs.831. In fact most industry watchers feel this increase still won't take India anywhere near the per capital spends of even comparable countries like China (Rs.1640) or Brazil(Rs.12,747), forget the US(Rs.1.70 lakh) or Japan (Rs.1.22 lakh).

Cardiovascular needs of the people

Dr. R.R. Kasliwal, Sr. Consultant (Cardiology), Escorts heart Institute & research Centre, New Delhi made a presentation on Meeting the Cardiovascular needs of people. Elaborating the scenario of the heart diseases worldwide via-s-via India. Dr. Kasliwal observed that the cases of heart diseases are very high in India. It occurs in nearly one-third of the patients who undergo bypass surgery, which is less than 13%. He stated that by 2017, 36% of all male and 33% of female deaths would be due to heart attacks and there would be an increase in CVD



make the people aware of the disease and prevent it from cardiac ailments and there is a large incidence of coronary heart disease. The prevalence of these diseases in India is very high 105.6 per thousand. The risk factors include high blood pressure, heredity, diabetes, obesity and sedentary life style. He also outlined few generic measures like less strain/stress, avoiding drinks, smoking and other kinds of anxieties and depressions to prevent the disease, for and improved quality and quantity of life in future.

Dr. Kasliwal urged for a national effort, particularly with respect to regional heart policy for the prevention of disease — mortality and morbidity, cardio-vascular risk studies, efficient system of surveillance, identification of other risk factors and determinants of health behavior in the society. He cautioned that by the year 2015, India is predicted to be a diabetes capital of the world. The need of the hour, he said is the community based program. Quality and quantity of healthcare should be our main motto, he added>(*Source:www.ficci-self. org)

Demographic Details

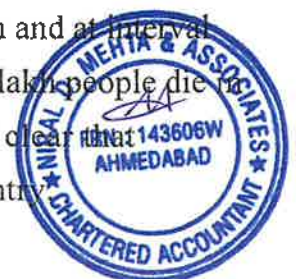
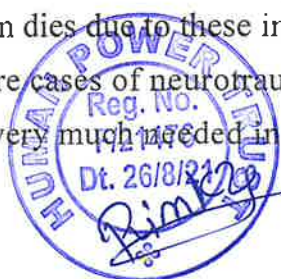

- 6 No facility is available for postgraduate super specialty study, training and research in the field of medical science and technology.

So after preliminary market on assessment of needs supply and demand of these health services and after due consideration of initial difficulty time requirement to stabilize the hospital and need to safeguard against financial setbacks due to lower utilization of maximum productive capacity during the initial phase, we have decided to include comprehensive range of services for treatment of patients with various disorders with a complete range of inpatient out patient and ambulatory services.

Considering the demand supply situation, absence of all super specialized care facilities under one roof the track record of the doctors associated and the facilities of the MM Super Specialty Hospitals and research center as super specialty Hospital offering state-of-the art tertiary care, Multi speciality Hospital cum Medical college is not expected to face any difficulties.

9. SOCIO ECONOMIC BENEFITS

Given the positioning of the Multi speciality Hospital cum Medical college Center as a Center for Excellence, it is expected that large number of resident Indians, who go abroad for super specialty care like cardiac treatment, will patronize the Multi specialty Hospital cum Medical college. This will save precious foreign exchange for the country. The Hospital is also expected to attract Non-resident Indians (NRIs), who can get super specialty treatment of world standard in India, at a price that would be a small fraction of the costs that would otherwise be incurred in leading American and European hospitals. This will earn foreign exchange for the country.



The Hospital will provide health care packages at a reasonable and affordable cost public at large. The Hospital proposes to reserve 45% of the beds for poor patients who cannot otherwise afford to get themselves treated for their ailments.

The Multi speciality Hospital cum Medical college will also strive to create awareness among all sections of the society about various ailments and preventive aspects of the diseases. It will regular hear education programs and continued medical education programs for practicing doctors as well as the common man.
